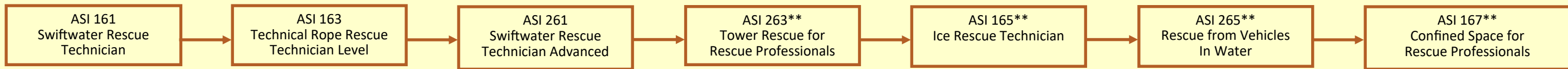


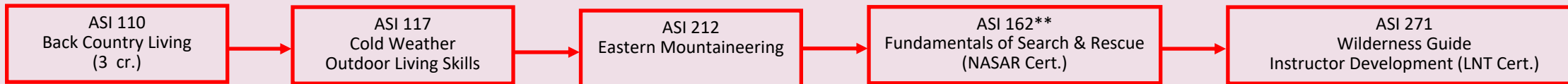
Diagrammed ASI Field Course Sequences
